

Call for volunteers: AzPA Education Committee Member

Are you passionate about advancing the field of pharmacy and ensuring the highest standards of education for pharmacy professionals? The Arizona Pharmacy Association (AzPA) is seeking dedicated individuals to join its Education Committee. As a committee member, you will have the opportunity to shape and contribute to the development of educational opportunities for pharmacy professionals in Arizona.

About the Committee: The Education Committee is a standing committee that plays a crucial role in meeting the continuing education interests of Arizona-licensed and certified pharmacy professionals. The committee operates throughout the year, meeting once per month via Zoom from September to May, with assigned tasks and responsibilities between meeting dates.

Key Responsibilities: The Education Committee is entrusted with several critical charges, including:

1. Peer review of Continuing Pharmacy Education (CPE) accredited activities in accordance with Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education (ACPE) standards.
2. Collaborating with staff to identify educational topics based on annual assessment data for meetings, webinars, and online learning.
3. Reviewing and recommending sessions received through the annual call for submissions.
4. Assessing Fall Conference, Spring Clinical, and Annual Convention sessions during live meetings.
5. Conducting peer reviews of session titles, descriptions, learning objectives, and assessment questions for education programs.
6. Evaluating the content of educational program presentations.
7. Ensuring that submitted proposals reflect exceptional presentations worthy of acceptance through the call for submissions process.
8. Proposing candidates for opening sessions at meetings.
9. Evaluating submitted poster abstracts for the Annual Convention.
10. Participating in the evaluation of posters at the Annual Convention.

Qualifications: To be considered for this position, candidates should possess the following qualifications:

- Member of the Arizona Pharmacy Association (AzPA).
- A strong commitment to advancing pharmacy education and professional development.
- Familiarity with ACPE standards and guidelines for accredited educational activities (preferred).
- Experience as a CE presenter/author/contributor on the state or national level
- Note: PGY2 residents with a mentor are welcome to serve on the education committee.
